## Restoring The George Washington Bridge

Speaker: Michael Wallace, PANYNJ



"Restoring The George" is a two billion capital investment for one of the worlds busiest bridges. Topics discussed will be an overview, work to date, suspender ropes, etc.



First opened in 1931, the George Washington Bridge (GWB) remains structurally sound and vital today due to the Port Authority's commitment to ongoing maintenance and investment to address the wear-and-tear and renewal of this 90-year-old crossing. Every year, more than 50 million eastbound automobiles, buses, and trucks travel across the bridge, making it the busiest bridge in the world.

The "Restoring the George" program comprises a \$1.9 billion investment in 11 state of good repair projects that will maintain the structural health of the facility over the next decade for the millions of customers who use it every year.

## PRESENTER: MICHAEL C. WALLACE, P.E., LEED AP, ENV SP

Mike has 31+ years engineering experience in the Construction Management of Major Capital Projects at all Port Authority Facilities. He began his career in the Port Authority as a summer intern in their Materials Engineering Unit and has held positions in the Construction Management Division in many PA Facilities including JFK and Newark Liberty International Airport, New York and New Jersey Marine Terminals, Hoboken Waterfront Development, and many Regional Development Facilities. He was the Deputy Chief of Construction before being promoted to Chief of Construction where he is responsible for directing and managing all construction work for Port Authority Capital and Operating Projects that are under the authority of the Chief Engineer.
